How it Works

The Hazon Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program at the J is an opportunity for you to pre-purchase locally-grown, fresh, organic produce from a farmer in your community. Purchase a "share" for the 2012 season, then pick up your vegetables at the J every Wednesday from June through October.

Why it Matters

Eating local, organic vegetables not only supports a local farmer, but it also preserves farmland and builds community. You'll be feeding your family healthy food and promoting a healthier lifestyle, plus building awareness of environmental issues in the Jewish community. If you are unable to pick up your food, it is donated to the Harvey Kornblum Jewish Food Pantry.

What's New for 2012?

- Every week you'll receive four servings of six different vegetables. Shares are no longer based on weight.
- Pick up your produce in a rolling cooler that you'll return the following week.
- If you have a small household and want to purchase a half share, you won't have to find someone to share with. Just purchase a half share and pick up every other week.

Registration Information

This agreement between the JCC of St. Louis and the undersigned is entered into for the 2012 growing season scheduled to commence the first week of June, 2012, or as produce harvest times shall occur, and ceasing on or about the last week of October, 2012, or as the growing season ends.

- 1) Participant understands that each weekly delivery from Dry Dock Farm will consist of four servings of six vegetable varieties per share per week (half shares will receive a full share every other week), and will vary depending on many factors such as, but not limited to, crops in season and crop yield of individual produce items.
- 2) Participant understands that Dry Dock Farm plans to grow enough produce to meet the delivery schedule but cannot guarantee exact amounts because of the obvious weather and other uncertain elements of farming. Dry Dock Farm will make every effort to meet the need, but no money will be refunded in case of limited availability of produce in any given week.
- 3) Participant agrees to pick up produce from the chosen designated delivery locations below. Once location is selected, no changes can be made. Should the subscriber not be available to pick up produce during the designated times in any given week, the entire share of produce that week will be donated to the Harvey Kornblum Jewish Food Pantry.
- 4) Dry Dock Farm represents and warrants to the subscribers that the produce furnished shall be grown without using synthetic pesticides, herbicides or growth hormones unless otherwise notified.
- 5) To guarantee enrollment, participant must return this signed agreement along with payment by March 31, 2012.
